This is a short update from the SPCC Committee to let you know that we are still working hard to try to get improvements to existing routes, and create new ones, for cyclists of all abilities, and also for walkers, and wheelchair-users.

Annual General Meeting: Our Annual General Meeting will take place on Tuesday 25th June, at 7.15pm, at the Church Room, Chelmondiston. We would love to see you at the AGM, and are always on the lookout for new, keen committee/co-opted members. We meet approximately every six weeks, though there are always other things going in between times.

Alton Water Triathlon: We are also going to be present at the Triathlon event at Alton Water on the 14th July, and are hoping to recruit some new members (membership is now free, of course), to give us even more credibility when it comes to negotiating with the local councils, and other bodies. We will be at Alton water from 9.00am to 12 noon.

We would also like to hear from any of you who ever cycle, or indeed walk, to or from Ipswich via Wherstead, and your experience of crossing the A14 slip-roads. This route is actually identified by Suffolk County Council as an Advisory Cycle Route on the Ipswich Cycle Map, (with the proviso that the footway section from Bourne Hill and over the A14 should be walked). Our view is that the slip-road crossings are hazardous, with poor visibility, and need to be improved, but so far all requests to improve matters (dropped kerbs where there are none, cutting back of brambles in the visibility splays etc) have fallen on deaf ears.
